What to do in 2022?

The new Whistleblowing legislation has already been adopted. All entities operating within the EU must comply with non-retaliation obligations, and those with more than 50 employees must also implement internal reporting channels.

Urgent action is needed to ensure compliance with the new legal framework by **18 June**.
